We are seeking an Assistant Professor with expertise in magnetic oxide thin films and magnetic measurement techniques. The successful candidate will collaborate closely with Professor Yanagihara to manage the laboratory and advance research in these areas. In addition to research responsibilities, the candidate will contribute to education by delivering lectures and supervising practical training within Master's and Doctoral Programs in Engineering Sciences, Subprogram in Applied Physics, and College of Engineering Sciences.
